SCOTT FRIDLEY, CAMP DIRECTOR Heads into his 19th year as founder and director of the Anderson Soccer Camps. Coach Fridley is starting his 20th year at Anderson University as the Head Men's Soccer Coach. He coached the AU women's team for 10 years from 2001 to 2010. Coach Fridley was a four year starter in goal for the Ravens and continues to hold many of the University's keeper records. He is nationally licensed by the NSCAA and the USSF. Coach Fridley's men's team has won 2 conference championships and 2 Post Season tournament championships in his tenure and registered over 150 wins. His team has been named NSCAA National Academic Award Winner for 16 years keeping over a team 3.0 GPA and has won the NSCAA Team Ethics awards for sportsmanship 4 times. Coach Fridley served 4 terms on the NCAA Tournament selection committee for soccer and serves on the NSCAA National Ethics committee. He currently serves as the DOC for Hoosier FC, a small elite youth soccer club in Noblesville, IN. Coach Fridley has coached 23 years of youth travel soccer and has recorded over 300 wins in his club career. He graduated from Anderson University with a degree in business and a minor in Christian Ministries. Coach Fridley graduated from Wauwatosa East High School in Milwaukee, Wisconsin where he played High School and club for the Milwaukee Kickers. He resides in Anderson, Indiana with his wife Wendy and his five children Aaron, Austin, Casey, Madison, and Mason.

BRAD CRUMBACHER, ASSISTANT DIRECTOR Returns for his 18th year with the Anderson Soccer Camps. Coach Crumbacher was a three-year starter at forward for Anderson University where he still holds many of the scoring records, including goals in a season with 19. He was the assistant coach at Anderson University from 1998 to 2002. He is licensed through the NSCAA and the USSF. Coach Crumbacher has coached youth travel for 13 years. He is from Xenia, Ohio where he played high school and club ball. Coach Crumbacher currently trains club teams in Columbus, Ohio. He resides in Columbus, Ohio with his wife Jill and daughters Anna and Abby.

JENNIFER MYHRE, CAMP STAFF Returns for her 3rd year with the Anderson Soccer Camps. Coach Myhre is beginning her 3rd year as the Anderson University Women's Soccer Coach. She was the assistant women's soccer coach at Carnegie Mellon University for two years. Coach Myhre graduated Summa Cum Laude from Messiah College in 2008. During her four years playing at Messiah, the Falcons captured the NCAA Division III National Championship in 2005, were semi-finalists in 2004 and 2006, and tournament finalists in 2007. Coach Myhre holds her NSCAA National Diploma, as well as a USSF "C" coaching license. She coaches club soccer for Hoosier FC's Under 12/16 girls elite team. She currently resides in Anderson, Indiana.

DAVID RAY, CAMP STAFF Returns for his 6th year as a staff member for Anderson Soccer Camps after serving four years as a camp counselor. Coach Ray played four years at Anderson University. He is licensed through the NSCAA and USSF. Coach Ray grew up in Anderson, IN where he played and eventually coached with the AASA Blitz and Anderson High School. He is currently the women's head coach at Colfax HS as well as the 49rs United Hot Shots girls select club team coach. Coach Ray resides in Northern California.

BRIAN SIMPSON, CAMP STAFF Returns for his 3rd year with the Anderson Soccer Camps. Coach Simpson was a 3 year letter winner at Anderson University on the men's team. He currently is the assistant coach for Anderson University's Mens Soccer Team. Coach Simpson works as the Youth Director for Hoosier FC (Noblesville, IN) and coach's the U13 boys which play in the MRL. He spent the previous 3 years as the Pendleton Heights girls high school soccer team and DOC for the Pendleton Youth Soccer Association. He holds the NSCAA Advanced National coach's license. Coach Simpson resides in Pendleton with his wife Rachel.

DREW ZELLERS, CAMP STAFF Returns for his 7th year as a staff member for Anderson Soccer Camps after serving 5 years as a camp counselor. Coach Zellers is currently coaching in Columbus, Ohio for Olentangy Classics FC and Classics Eagles FC. He is also the Head Women's Coach at Olentangy High School. Coach Zellers holds the NSCAA Advanced National license and the USSF C license. He resides in Columbus, Ohio.

BOBBY HOLDEN, GOALKEEPING STAFF TRAINER Returns for his 6th year as the goalkeeping instructor for the Anderson Soccer Camps after serving 1 year as a counselor. He was a four year letterman at Anderson University as a goalkeeper. Coach Holden played at Greenfield Central High and club for the Greenfield Strikers. He also played 1 year for the Indiana Select Amateur team. Coach Holden does individual, team, and club goalkeeping instruction. He currently serves as the Head's Men Soccer Coach at New Palestine High School. Coach Holden is the DOC for USF Real and runs his own keeper programs. He has become known as one of the top keeper trainers in Indiana. Coach Holden holds the NSCAA Advanced National Diploma. Coach Bobby currently resides in Greenfield, Indiana.
